



Fei Tian Academy of the Arts (FTAA) has a rolling admissions policy and accepts applications year-round. Students interested in pursuing studies at FTAA should submit their completed application packages three months prior to the start of the academic session in which they intend to first enroll.

A completed application package includes:

- A completed and signed application form, available at www.feitianacademy.org;
- Payment to cover the application fee in the amount of \$40 (domestic) or \$80 (international) — waived for the current year;
- An official copy of transcripts or report cards for all previous primary/secondary level studies, if available;
- A copy of the child's birth certificate and passport biographic data page;
- A copy of the child's immunization records;
- At least one recommendation letter from a teacher;
- At least two recent photographs of the applicant, in a digital format (full-length frontal and full-length back);
- At least two recent photographs of the applicant performing splits and a bridge in dance attire or other form-fitting clothing (for dance students); and
- A video of a music performance by the applicant (for music students).

Applications must be completed in English. If any records are in a language other than English, applicants should have the records translated into English and certified. If school records are not available, applicants must request a letter certifying the year(s) of school attended.

After passing the initial screening based on the completed application package, applicants and their parents or legal guardians will be scheduled for a live audition or interview.

Admittance and placement are based primarily on performance during the audition or interview, the desire of the applicant and applicant's parents/guardians for an education based on the principles of Falun Dafa, and the applicant's previous transcripts.

Those who accept an offer of admission to FTAA should understand that they may be placed in a grade level different from their level in the previous school. In particular, those not yet performing at the required level for their age may be placed in a lower grade.

A probationary period of one year is required for all new students. Parents or legal guardians will be notified of any concerns or any recommended changes in placement by the end of the first year of the student's attendance at Fei Tian.

Any application found to contain false information may result in the student being denied enrollment or being immediately dismissed from FTAA.
